CHRIS MOORE'S SURPRISE BULLSHARK

The day was all planned, Kaz and I would take his new found love, "Insanity" - a 21ft Tradewind Trihull - out on the water to christen her with her first-time shark fishing. The weather was set to be glorious inside the bay, sunny, clear skies, top of 30 degrees with winds no more than 10 knots from the east, so we set out to anchor towards the southern end of the Sandhills.

I was all set. I had my Tiagra 50w overhead reel setup with reel bent fishing braid and leader with 26/0 hook and we had floated some mac tuna out for bait. I couldn't tell you how long it took to hook up, but I knew I had something big once it happened.



Kaz and I agreed, I needed to fight this 'thing' from the beach, so we weighed anchor and slowly made our way in. For up to an hour, my legs, shoulders, arms and core were all burning from the amount of strength it took to hold on. There were so many times when I thought the fight was almost over; we would have sight of it from the boat so we'd start driving it to the shore but without fail this, now confirmed bull shark, had a lot more fight in it taking more line back out – I had to keep fighting, I had to push through my fatiguing muscles.

Once we got close enough to the shore, I jumped in and fought it from the beach. It was the most incredible feeling seeing this amazing creature being pulled in closer and closer. Finally, it was close enough for Kaz to rope its tail so we could keep it under control to measure, tag and get some photos to ensure that moment will never be forgotten. 9ft long, 4ft girth, approximately 175kg.

The feeling was unlike any other; like I had just run a marathon, my legs were absolutely burning, my heart pounding and my hands aching, but I had done it. I had just caught my very first bull shark.

We removed the hook and then Kaz swam it out holding on to this amazing animal. Once it was deep enough, we watched it swim away back into the depths of Moreton Bay. I was beyond amazed at what I had just achieved, you couldn't wipe the smile off my face.

I definitely earned a cold one after that.

FY2021 - 2022 AGM WEIGHMASTER REPORT

This was my first year as a member of the MBGFC Committee and in the club's Weighmaster role (and Acting Fishing Captain in lieu of anyone else taking on this role). Given the number of members in our club, I have found it surprising as to how few activity reports are being submitted – I conclude that this is either a reflection of very few of our members fish or those that do fish are not submitting activity reports.

Throughout the year I have been actively working on various initiatives that will hopefully lead to more member engagement and fishing throughout the next fishing year – these will be discussed in more detail later in this report.

Fishing Activity:

There were 21 activity records submitted in the fishing year 01/07/21 to 30/06/22. This reported activity involved 6 club boats and 12 club anglers (plus multiple non-club anglers). Within those reports, there were 48 fish caught in-bounds and 4 fish out-of-bounds (52 in total with all being in Qld waters) – 26 were captured & 26 were released. A breakdown by species of the 52 total fish caught is as follows:

Barracuda 1 Marlin – Blue 3 Spanish Mackerel 2
Mahi-Mahi 30 Marlin – Striped 2 Tuna – Skipjack 3
Marlin – Black 6 Sailfish 1 Tuna – Yellowfin 1

Club Records:

This year I have re-established the club's records register for eligible gamefish species (using historical records registers – retrospectively applying the club record categories outlined below) and will continue to update these records as club anglers continue to improve on the records set by those before them. The latest club record register can be accessed from the MBGFC website.

To be considered for a new Club Record, the captured fish needs to be an eligible gamefish species that was caught in MBGFC local waters by an angler who was a financial club member (whose membership saw them affiliated with QGFA) at the time of the capture.

Submissions for club records (including proposed amendments to existing club records) should be made in writing to the club weighmaster.

N.B. MBGFC record categories are (consistent with latest GFAA record categories):

Record Description Eligibility Criteria:

All-tackle: all line classes, male or female, any age Overall (O): for respective line class, male or female, any age Men (M): for respective line class, male that is 16 years or older at time of capture. Women (W): for respective line class, female that is 16 years or older at time of capture.

Junior Male (JM): for respective line class, for a male that is 11 years or older but not yet 16.

Junior Female (JF): for respective line class, for a female that is 11 years or older but not yet 16.

Small Fry Male (SFM) for respective line class, for a male that is not yet 11 years old.

Small Fry Female (SFF) for respective line class, for a female that is not yet 11 years old.

New club records that were set in the 2021-22 fishing year included:

14/08/21 – Harry Billing with an 82kg Striped Marlin on 37kg – JM37 & O37 club records. This was also a JM37 Qld record.

13/12/21 – Warren Meads with an 11kg Mahi Mahi on 8kg – M8 club record.

16/06/22 – Barry Parker with a 0.95kg Mahi Mahi on 3kg – M3 & O3 club records.

24/06/22 – Adam Donohue with a 20.5kg Mahi Mahi on 37kg – JM37 & O37 club records.

Competitions:

The club's annual "Back to Tangas" comp didn't happen this year. It was postponed from March to May due to COVID Restrictions (noting that the weather on the original March weekend was not conducive for fishing) and then cancelled due to bad weather on the postponed May weekend.

The club's fishing competitions for the year (in addition to the annual trophies) were left to the Fish of the Month (FotM) competitions. These FotM competitions had remained as free entry for all members throughout the year, with entry requiring the successful angler to post about their fishing trip on the "MBGFC Members Only" facebook group and submit their associated activity record to the club weighmaster.

Prizes for these competitions were typically a \$50 voucher (BCF or Boating & RV) to the competition winner. Results for the FotM competitions for the year were:

- **Nov21** – Yellowfin Tuna – 1st one caught by a senior and 1st one caught by a junior. Prizes went unclaimed
- **Dec21** – Mahi Mahi – Highest Point Scoring Fish – won by Warren Meads 165pts (11kg fish on 8kg)
- **Jan22** – Black Marlin – Highest Aggregate Score. Unclaimed prize (no points were awarded for black marlin)
- **Feb22** – Black Marlin – Highest Aggregate Score. Unclaimed prize (no points were awarded for black marlin)
- **Mar22** – Mackerel (any species) – Highest Point Scoring Fish. Unclaimed prize (no mackerel caught)
- **Apr22** – Any Gamefish Species - Highest Point Scoring Fish. Unclaimed prize (no points awarded)
- **Jun22** – Any Gamefish Species - Highest Point Scoring Fish (plus a 1st & 2nd Jnr Prize) - won by Warren Meads - 300pts (Mahi Mahi tagged on 3kg); 1st Junior prize to Adam Donohue 62pts (20.5kg Mahi Mahi on 37kg). 2nd junior prize went unclaimed.

Scales:

This year MBGFC purchased a second set of digital scales (Rinstrum HS-160). These scales will complement the existing digital scales (CAS IE-1700A) owned by the club. The capabilities of both sets of scales are noted below:

Rinstrum HS-160; Range 0-160kg, 50g increment CAS IE-1700A: Range 4-500kg, 200g increment.

The club shall maintain annual calibration certification for both scales so that they are ready for use should a potential record fish need to be weighed – club members should contact the club weighmaster should either of these scales be required. N.B. personal scales can be used for weighing fish that aren't being claimed as potential QGFA, GFAA or IGFA records.

Club Record Keeping:

This year I have developed a spreadsheet to assist with internal record keeping of caught fish (captured or released) for the club (in addition to updating QGFA Gamebase with all Activity Record data). This spreadsheet lends itself to provide more flexibility in generating reports such as the monthly weighmaster reports (a report that I have introduced this year that updated & issued as part of each monthly members meeting – noting that this is withheld for the last few months of a fishing year to keep annual trophies a surprise) and confirmation of competition results (be they FotM comps or annual points score).

QGFA Heat Maps:

Our club's affiliation with QGFA (& GFAA) sees the ongoing commitment of our members to maintaining an active involvement in the research that can be achieved from the recreational game fishing we all enjoy.

Recording details of gamefish species being caught (whether they are kept for consumption or released) by our members is combined with similar details being gathered by other QGFA affiliated club anglers. This year our members (along with all QGFA affiliated clubs) have seen the combined effort of the research (data collection) that has been undertaken for a number of years returned for the combined benefit of all QGFA affiliated anglers by way of "heat maps" providing our club (shared with our members at members nights) with the ability to understand historically where and at what times of the year different species of gamefish have been caught over the past 10+ years – recognising that the information we are able to obtain from the QGFA heat maps is directly proportional to the collective effort we provide with our individual activity reports, our efforts in submitting activity reports should see all of us benefit from ongoing further data collection providing further updated information for us to use in years to come.

Not only does this research provide feedback as to where we may choose to focus our fishing efforts in the future, the ongoing capture of fishing related data allows our members to share fishing information as the season progresses and also ensures all members are active participants in our annual points scores and associated trophies.

Member Engagement Projects:

I joined the club a few years ago when I moved to the area – I was looking to meet like-minded people who shared an enjoyment for game fishing and were willing to share their knowledge of the sport and the local area. As a new-comer to the club, I had felt there were limited opportunities for me to meet other club members and without being able to make contact in person, it was difficult for me to know who other members of the club were and how I could find people that I may want to invite onto my boat (or get invited onto someone else's boat).

This year I have been actively pushing to see more opportunities for our members to meet and discuss fishing via regular monthly meetings. To hopefully further attract more of our members to be actively involved in game fishing and participate in the data gathering process that is associated with the research side of game fishing (i.e. submission of Activity Records), in collaboration with other MBGFC committee members, we have developed and with agreement by the committee we have introduced a new points scoring system and fishing rules at a club level that will commence at the start of the next fishing season (01/07/22).

These initiatives include::

1. Introduction of a MBGFC rule booklet – key elements of the book are:

a. Club Fishing Rules Review – includes update of previous rules to pick up line classes recently introduced by QGFA (i.e. 15 & 24kg in 80-150m depth) and reflect introduction of line classes not otherwise recognised by QGFA or GFAA.

b. Points Score Review – significant changes to club points to introduce all line classes (including braid) in all water depths as well as recognising "leader touch & release" and the addition of "measure & release" for annual club points score.

c. Gamefish Section Annual Trophy Review – we have dropped out some annual trophies that were very specific and typically resulting in a single fish collecting multiple trophies and introduced new trophies to encourage new anglers and small fry anglers;

d. Bottom Fish Section Introduced –a bottom fish section has been introduced with the aim to encourage members who potentially aren't into the finer points of game-fishing to become familiar with the concept of recording a fishing event to then progress toward game-fishing and the data collection (research element) side of the sport. An entry sheet specific for this annual competition (separate to QGFA Activity Records that should be used for gamefishing) has been created and available for download from the MBGFC website;

E. Fishing Locations Chart – a fishing locations chart has been created that shows named fishing regions within our club's local waters. This map includes grid referencing (5minute intervals) that Will allow better communication of an approximate area where something may be in the wide blue yonder (these grid reference details have also been introduced in the monthly weighmaster report[s]). The rule book and chart also documents the position of the Qld/NSW border (the Southern end of our local waters).

F. Other elements – booklet also includes information regarding tagging, a list of GPS coordinates for DPI FADs and Waverider Buoys, GFAA eligible game fish species, marlin species identification, fish length vs weight charts and the latest GFAA angling rules & equipment regulations.

2. Using content from the new club rules book, a "1-pager" has been generated that shows Fishing Locations Chart (with GPS coordinates for FADs and Waverider buoys) on one side of the page and on the reverse side is the new club point scoring guidelines and gamefish eligible species list;

3. Introduction of an Annual Events Calendar (including monthly members nights and fishing Rally Days along nominal "All Ports" competition weekends); and

4. Re-establishment of club records for all gamefish species.

Looking ahead for 2022/23 Fishing Year:

I offer to continue in my role as MBGFC weighmaster for the 2022/23 fishing year and hope that my efforts this year in developing initiatives that will encourage more fishing and engagement by our members have not been for nothing.

I look forward to regularly meeting with our club's fishing members, hearing of members' fishing adventures and receiving more activity records in the new fishing year.

QGFA FISHING ACTIVITY HEAT MAPS

The executive committee of the QGFA are continuing to look for ways to give back to all the members of the 20 Game Fishing Clubs that make up the QGFA, and in doing so, we are always trying to get more members engaged with their fishing clubs and getting them out there enjoying time on the water fishing with family and friends.

One of the innovations being developed by the QGFA team is an interactive “ACTIVITY HEAT MAP” report that easily filters activity sheet and tag card data out of the QGFA gamebase database and provides an easy-to-read map of past fishing activities.

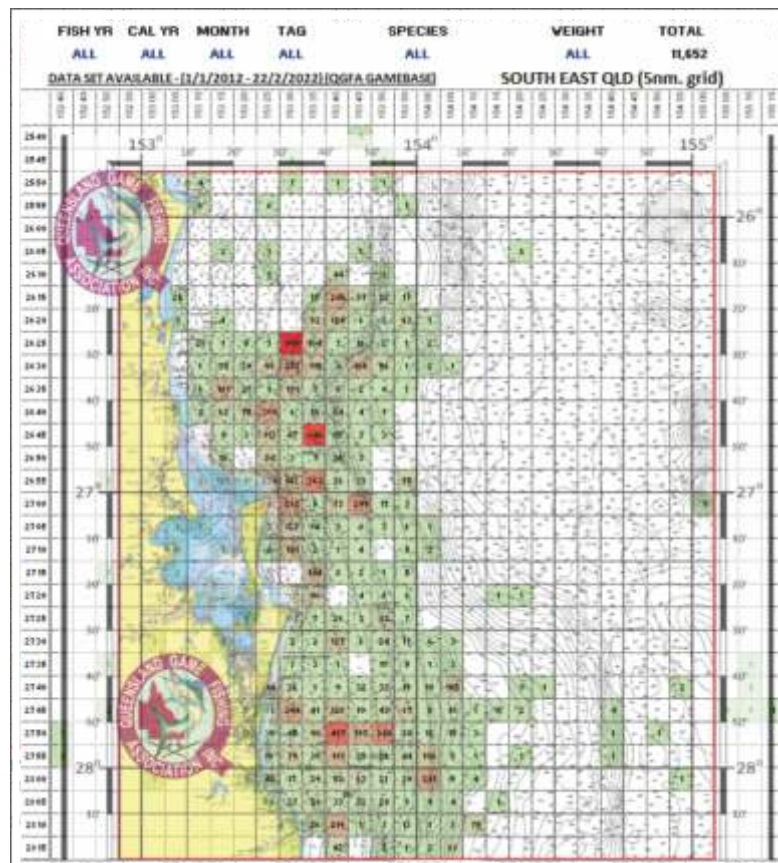
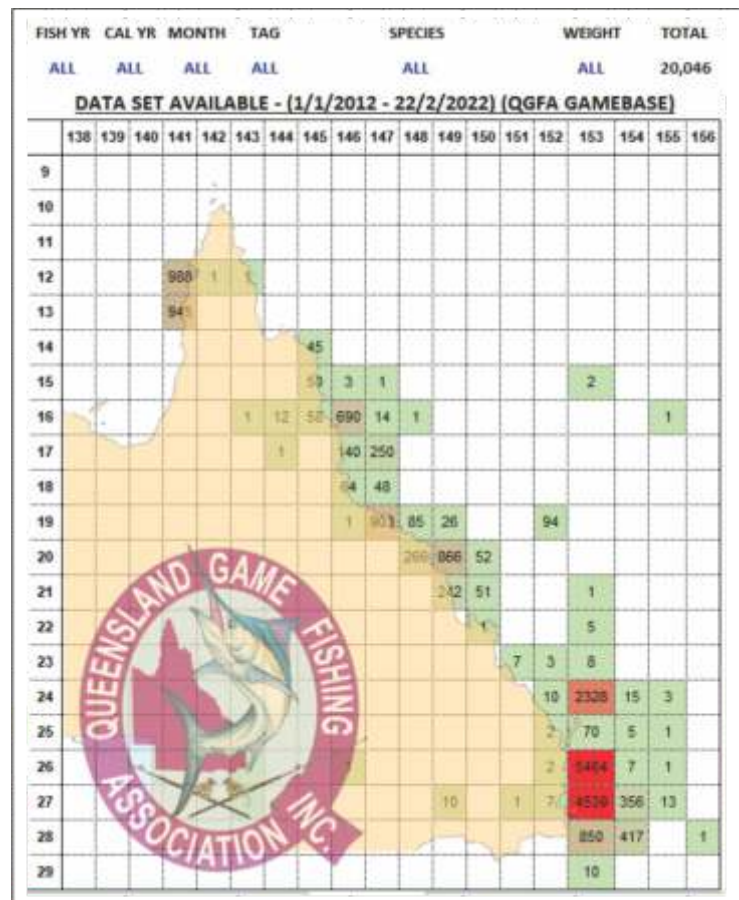
Thanks to the fishing and recording efforts of all our club's members over the past 10 years completing tag cards and activity sheets, and then the extra work from all the club captains and weighmasters entering the data into our QGFA gamebase system, we now have a database of over 20,000 entries to paint a very good picture in a “heat map” style report for all members to use.

This interactive report is only possible from the data collected and submitted by our clubs and their members into the QGFA gamebase system.

The interactive report allows filtering of:-

- Fishing Year (1 July – 30 June),
- Calendar Year (1 Jan - 31 Dec),
- Month,
- Tag Type (B-Billfish, A-Pelagic, S-Shark),
- Fish Species, and
- Fish Weight.

Once the filters are applied by selecting the values in drop down boxes at the top of the map, the number of records that exist in each grid square for that filter is returned in each grid square, an auto-colour function then highlights the grids that contain the larger numbers



on the map and creates the “heat map” effect on the map.

The “heat maps” are produced on a state level grid map in 1 degree (60nm) grid pattern for the whole of Queensland, and then supported with a series of 6 local region maps in 5-minute (5 nm) grid pattern increments.

The six (6) local region maps are South East QLD Region, Fraser Island Region, Mackay & Whitsunday Region, Townsville Region, Far North QLD East Region and Weipa Region.

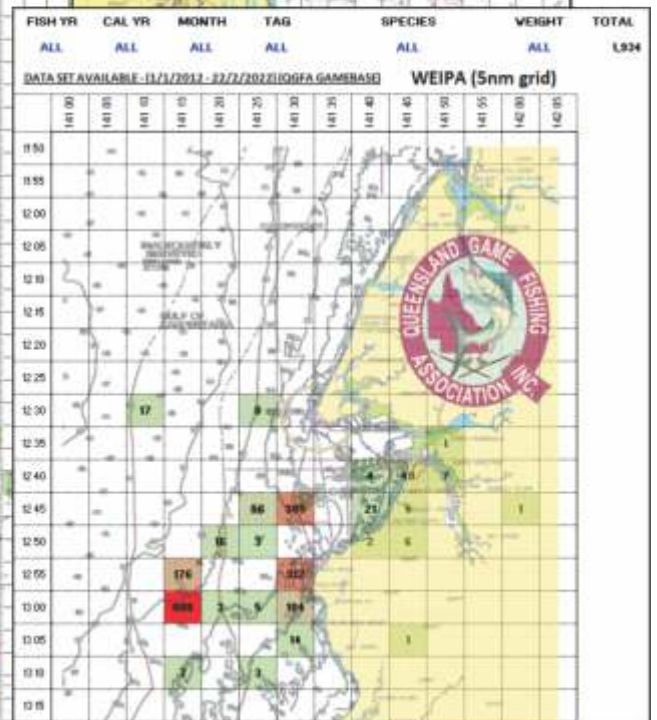
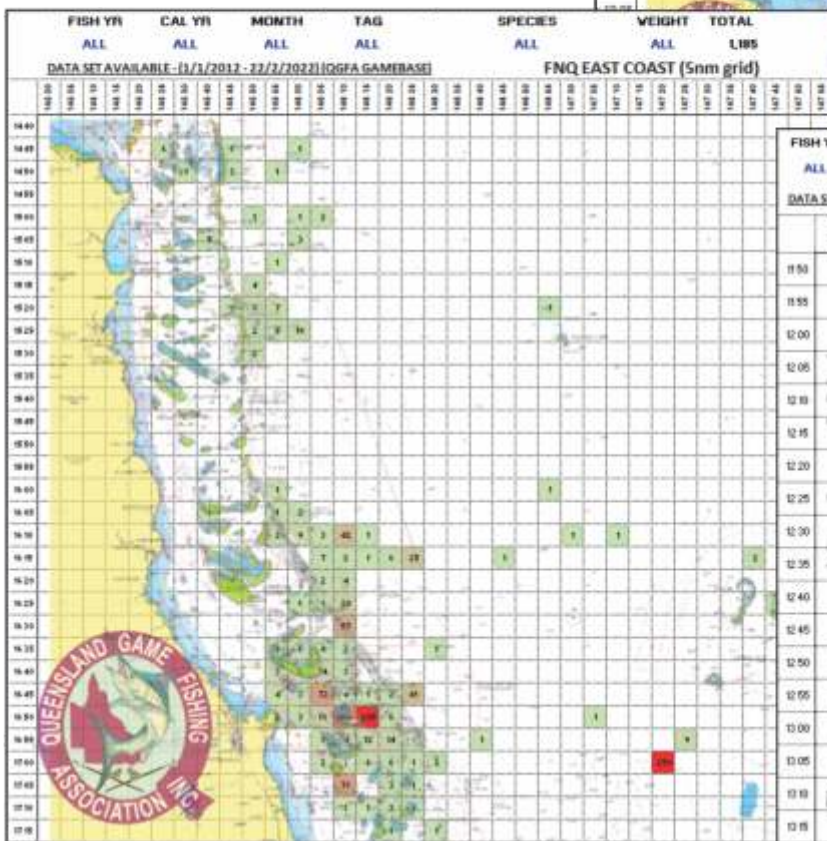
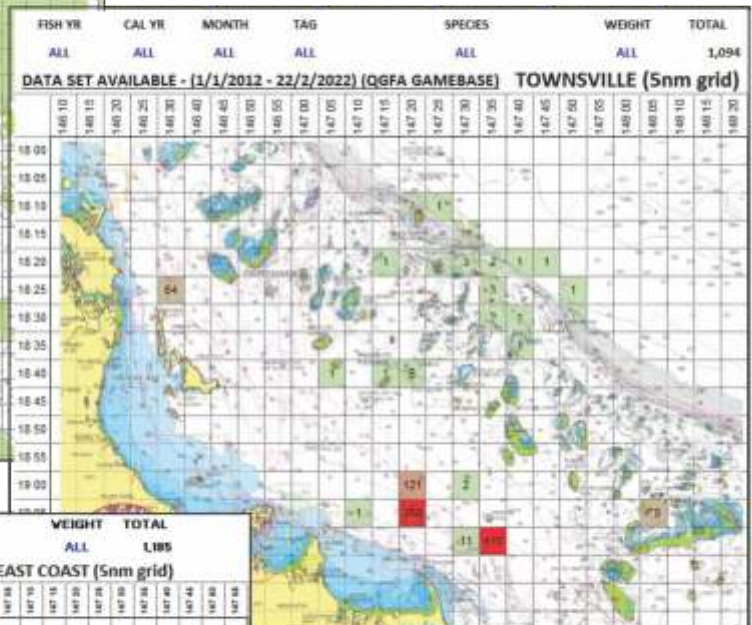
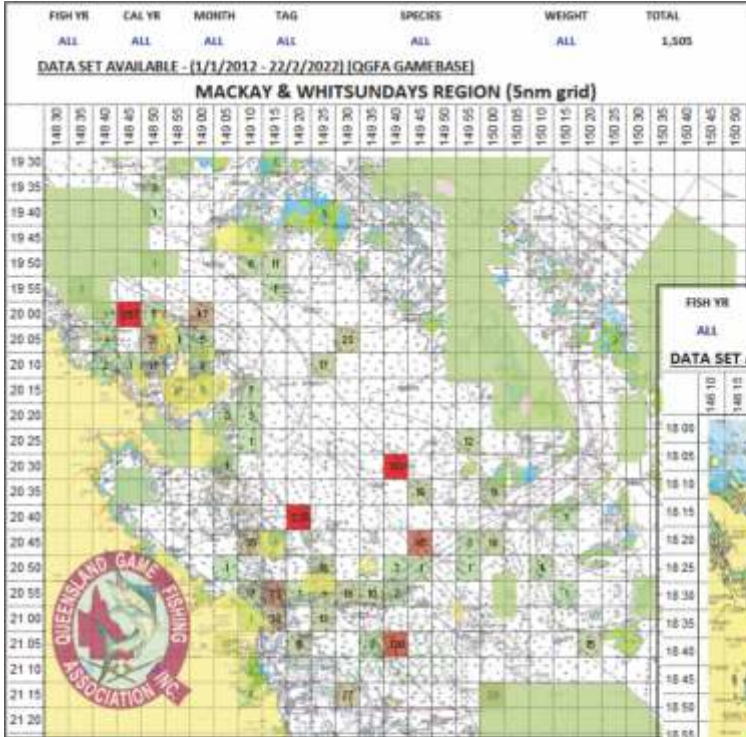
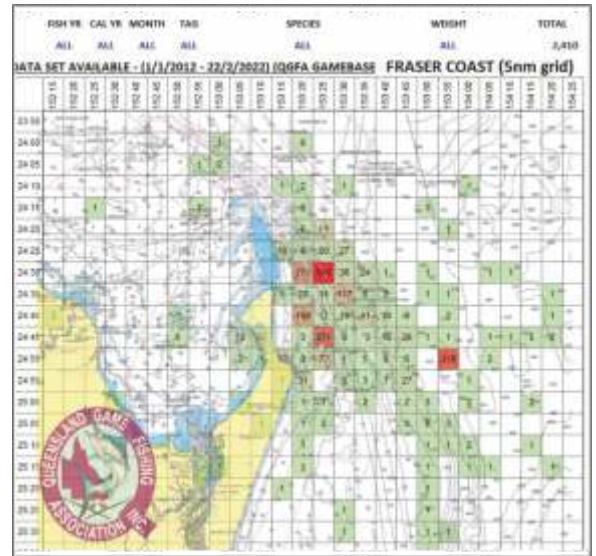
The interactive report is being released to clubs so they can conduct research and information sessions with their members, and may eventually lead to an

interactive report available on the QGFA website. This tool will allow all clubs to view the full QGFA database (back to 2012) for past fishing years (excluding the current fishing year), and each club will also have the ability to generate maps with their club's current fishing year and past fishing year results.

The filter labels are in blue at the top of the images and the total count of fish in the grid you are looking at is displayed in the top right corner above the grid map.

As you can see by the filter settings all images are showing the full data set currently in the QGFA gamebase database (from

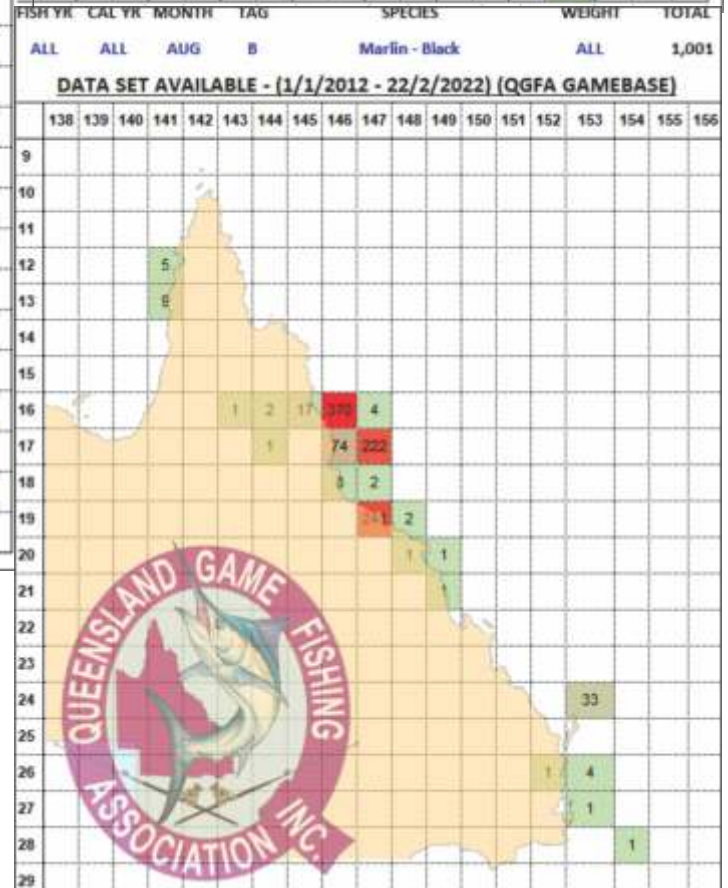
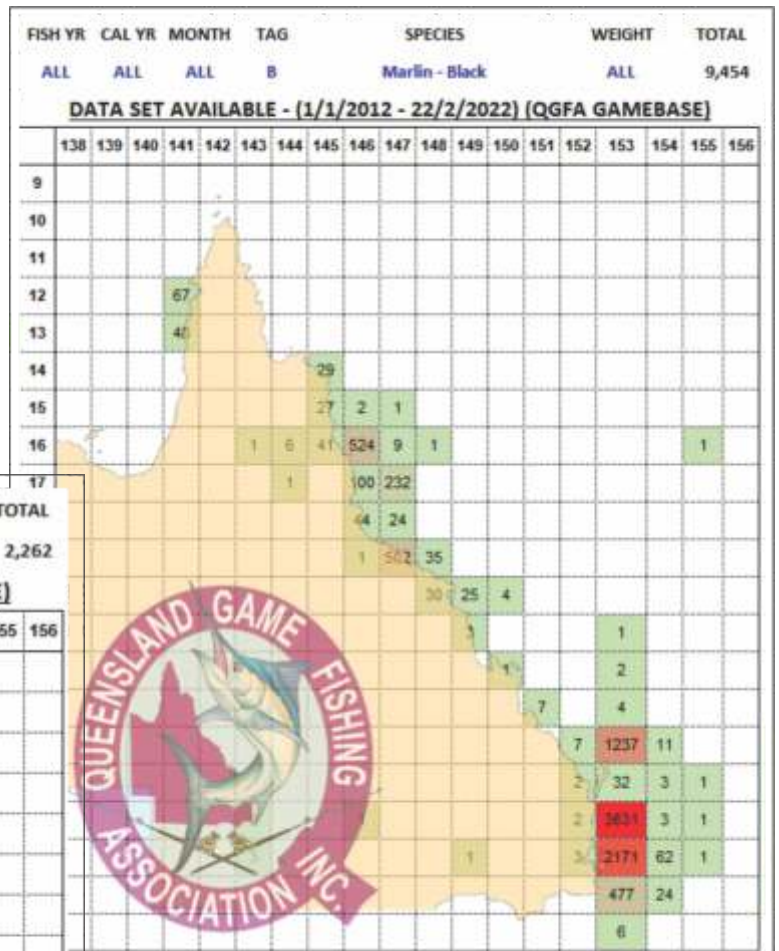
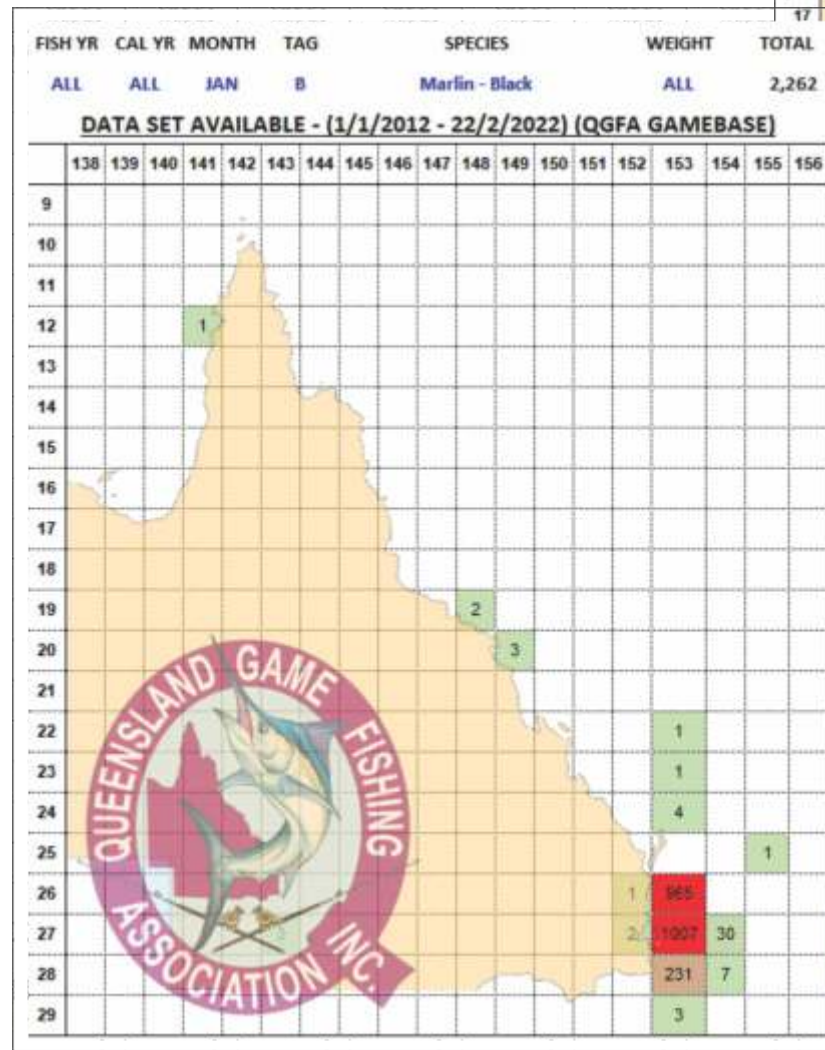

01/01/2012 to 22/02/2022).

There are untold possibilities of what people can then quickly & easily find using various combinations of the filters available with this report.

For example; If you wanted to chase a particular fish species – like a Black Marlin, you can simply apply the “Marlin – Black” “SPECIES” filter and “B” series “TAG” filter and see where Black Marlin have been tagged, and then in a few more clicks you can search by each “MONTH” to then work out when the black marlin season is in a particular region (for instance these



images show the difference between January and August Black Marlin tagging results).

NB. Keep in mind to read the TOTAL number in the top right corner above the map for the total sum of the values in the grid, and read the value on the grid square as well as look at the grid colour as all graphs will have the same colour red for the highest value on the chart (no matter how big that number is).....

Then once you have settled on where in the state you want to fish for your black marlin and what time of year, you can then apply these filters (“JAN”, “B” & “Marlin – Black”) to the local region map to show a breakdown of past results in that area.

QGFA still recommend anglers talk with clubs and members that are in the area to see how the current fishing is

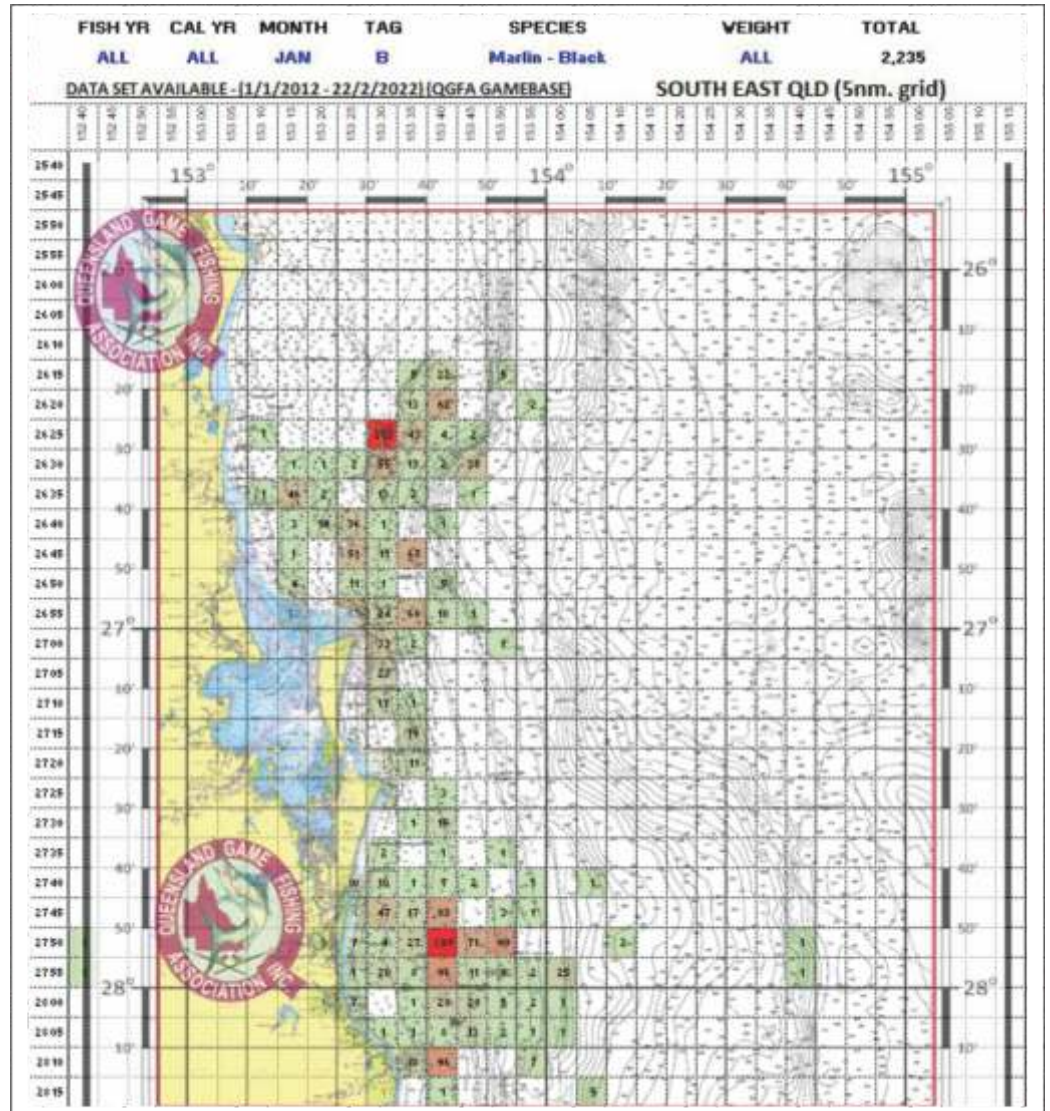
going and what techniques works best in that area, however, it is a tool to help get anglers started in the right direction and a tool for clubs to be able to easily research and interpret historical data for information sessions they may be trying to run with members. .

This interactive “heat map” report is a way of providing the many active members within the clubs of the QGFA with a first-hand appreciation of some of the benefits that comes from their efforts in participating in the tagging program (and correctly completing QGFA Activity Records and NSW Fisheries tag cards).

The reports will give the game fishing clubs that make up the QGFA more information to share back with their members. It will be a great tool to help introduce new members into game fishing with what fish to target in your local waters, while also giving information to experienced members that want to look to other areas than just their local waters to fish, in our great state.

Please remember the more accurate the club members complete the tag cards and activity sheets, the more accurate our club captains/ weighmasters can record this information in gamebase, and then in turn the more accurate of a picture we will be able to supply back to the members in this interactive report.

NEW MBGFC RULE BOOK

As mentioned in a previous article within this magazine, a rule book has been released by MBGFC for use from the start of the 2022/23 fishing year. A softcopy of the MBGFC rule book can be downloaded from the MBGFC website.

The Club Fishing Rules and Information Booklet provides anglers with an excellent reference source for those starting out in gamefishing through to experienced anglers and skippers with a range of information covered from club specific rules, **point scoring** and annual prize categories to more general information such as:

- Club "local waters" typical **fishing areas** and FAD locations;
- Tagging:
 - Tag types & best practice techniques;
 - How to complete tag cards & associated QGFA Activity Records (including submission to club weighmaster);
- Eligible gamefish species list;
- Marlin identification guide;
- Fish length vs weight for a number of gamefish species; and
- GFAA angling rules and equipment regulations.

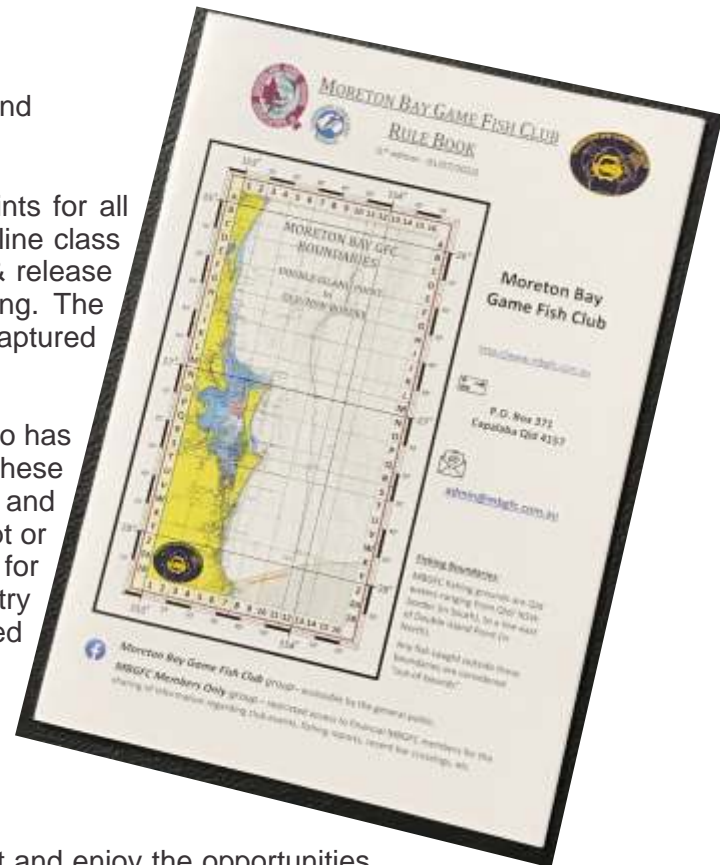
The club's rules allow anglers to accumulate annual club points for all gamefish species that are caught and released regardless of line class used (including braid) or water depth fished allowing for tag & release (T&R), measure & release (M&R) or leader & release (L&R) fishing. The club's point scoring also provides annual points for fish that are captured using all "mono" line classes in any water depth.

In addition to gamefishing annual prize categories, the club also has annual prizes for a number of bottom fish categories – fishing in these categories is independent of line-class (braid can be used) and prizes are awarded based on fish length (fish can either be kept or released). The club rule book outlines how to make submission for entry into these categories using the MBGFC bottom fish entry form (N.B. MBGFC bottom fish entry form can be downloaded from the MBGFC website).

On the following two pages is an extract from the new MBGFC rule book in relation to the new MBGFC Points Scoring which was effective from 01/07/22 and the Fishing Locations chart.

We hope you find the new MBGFC rules book of some benefit and enjoy the opportunities presented by the new points scoring system and bottom fish categories.

N.B. - Broadbill (Swordfish) is a Billfish, however shall be awarded 4x "BILLFISH" Release or Capture points

TUNA include: Bigeye, Dogtooth, Longtail, Pacific Bluefin, Southern Bluefin & Yellowfin Tunas only.

N.B. Any other tuna species are considered as "Other Species" for points score purposes.

OTHER SPECIES - Class A include: Albacore, Amberjack, Barramundi, Bonefish, Black Jewfish, Cobia, Giant Trevally, Mahi Mahi, Mulloway, Samsonfish, Sharks, Snapper, Spanish Mackerel, Yellowtail Kingfish & Wahoo

OTHER SPECIES - Class B include: All other game fish species recognised by GFAA that don't otherwise fit into any other category listed above

CAPTURE POINTS

* All captured fish must be legal length or longer and must be weighed to be eligible for Capture Points.

* For fish that are gilled & gutted, 10% shall be added to the measured weight to arrive at the total weight used for points calculation.

(N.B. Any potential QGFA, GFAA or IGFA record claims will require the fish to be weighed whole [DO NOT GUT & GILL prior to weighing])

* Fish caught on braid are not eligible for capture points score or club, QGFA or GFAA record claims.

* Calculated Billfish Capture points score shall be halved unless:

- captures are in excess of current record (QGFA, GFAA or IGFA); and

- claim for new record has been submitted to satisfaction of MBGFC weighmaster (N.B. not dependant on claim being successful).

RELEASE POINTS

* Only eligible species (noting minimum length requirements) shall be tagged (using the appropriate NSW DPI tag) and released (T&R).

* The tables below show full Release Points for fish that are tagged and released (T&R).

* Excluding billfish, anglers are limited to receiving Release Points (for T&R, M&R or L&R) for up to five fish per species per day. (5 best count)

* Any fish that is Measured & Released (per GFAA M&R eligibility & guidelines) shall receive:

- 70% of full Release Points if the species is also eligible for Tag & Release, or

- full Release Points if the species is not eligible for Tag & Release (N.B. nil points for Chinaman).

N.B. Fish awarded Release Points from shaded areas of tables are not eligible for QGFA or GFAA tag & release points.

* Any fish that is eligible for T&R, but is Leadered & Released [L&R] instead, shall receive half Release Points (N.B. nil QGFA or GFAA points for L&R).

N.B. Leader & Release [L&R] is if a mate touches leader, or swivel to rod tip, or leader (after mainline or double) to rod tip (refer club rules).

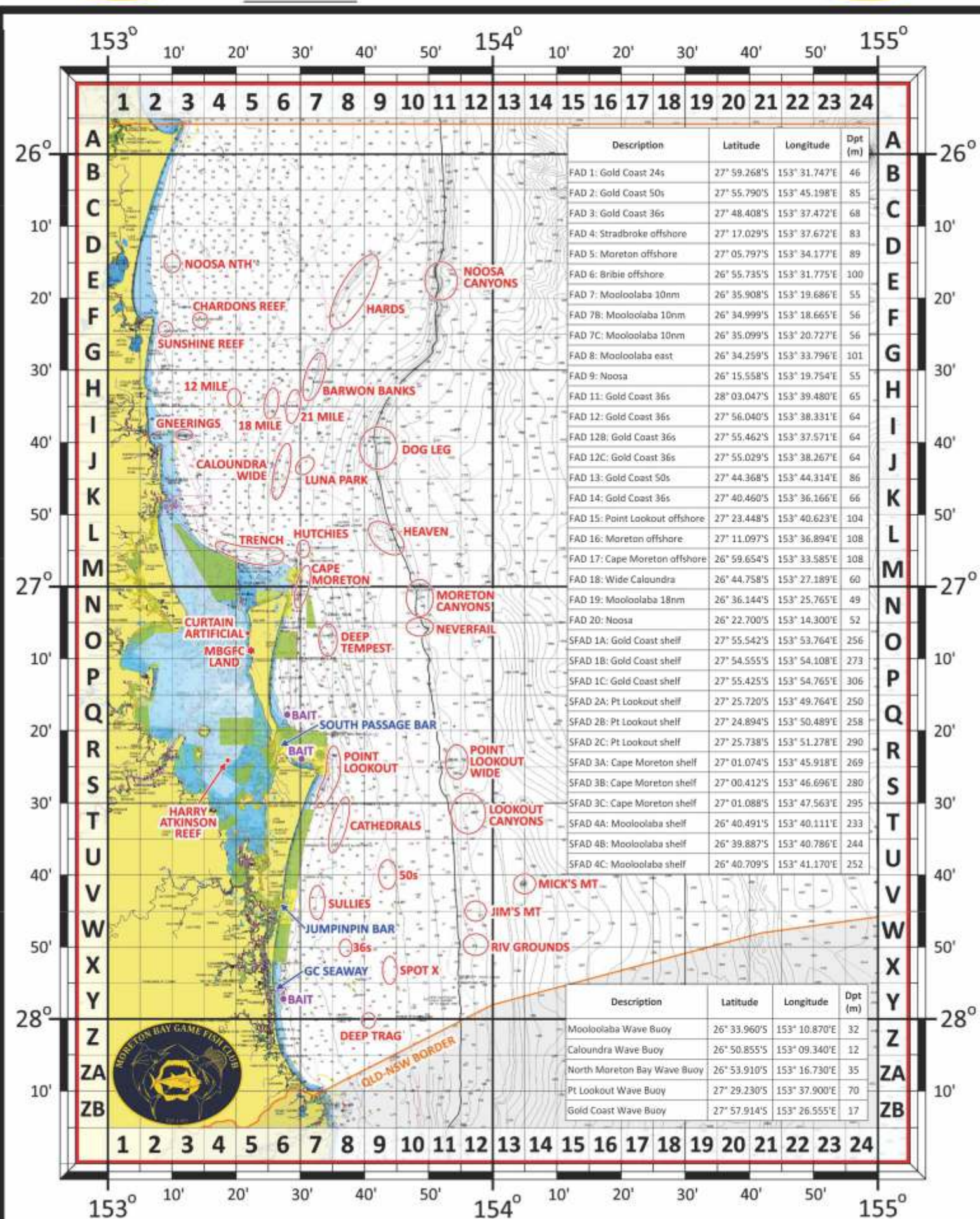

Re-established MBGFC Club Records Register

Moreton Bay Game Fishing Club's local waters have produced many angling records over the years, including Queensland, Australian and World Records.

In early 2022, the club reinstated its club records register for eligible gamefish species (using historical records registers) and will continue to update these records as club anglers continue to improve on the records set by those before them.

The latest club record register can be accessed from the MBGFC website – N.B. MBGFC record categories are:

Record Description	Eligibility Criteria
All-tackle:	all line classes, male or female, any age
Overall (O):	for respective line class, male or female, any age
Men (M):	for respective line class, male that is 16 years or older at time of capture
Women (W):	for respective line class, female that is 16 years or older at time of capture
Junior Male (JM):	for respective line class, for a male that is 11 years or older but not yet 16
Junior Female (JF):	for respective line class, for a female that is 11 years or older but not yet 16
Small Fry Male (SFM)	for respective line class, for a male that is not yet 11 years old
Small Fry Female (SFF)	for respective line class, for a female that is not yet 11 years old

To be considered for a new Club Record, the captured fish needs to be an eligible gamefish species that was caught in MBGFC local waters by an angler who was a financial club member (whose membership saw them affiliated with QGFA) at the time of the capture. Submissions for club records (including proposed amendments to existing club records) should be made in writing to the club weighmaster.

Please contact the club weighmaster if the club's certified hanging scales are required for a potential record claim.

The Club Records register covers the next 10 page.

MBGFC - CLUB HOUSE AND LAND RULES

1. All members wishing to use the Club facilities must notify the Secretary to obtain approval. Approval will only be considered if the Member has already signed an "Application for permission of MBGFC Ltd to enter upon land at Moreton Island" Form 37 for the current financial year and Club Land booking form. If applicant is under 18 years of age the application must be signed by a legal guardian. One form is to be filled out per family.

Club Land is for the use of members and their immediate family only (i.e. partner and children). Members may invite guests to stay at the club land on a one off introduction basis (fill in Form 37A). These guests would be expected to join the club if revisiting.

2. Fees are payable in advance and are:-

Members Tent Sites: \$35.00 per night – includes 4 campers, plus \$10.00 per extra camper on the same site.

Guests Tent Sites: \$45.00 per night – includes 4 campers, plus \$10.00 per extra camper on the same site.

Caravan/Cabin: \$50.00 per night – includes 4 guests plus \$10.00 per extra guest.

Moorings: Use of moorings is free for club members but if clubhouse facilities (showers & BBQ etc.) are used, a fee of \$10.00 per day will apply.

3. **Bookings** will only be accepted through the Club Secretary; and fees must be paid in advance. There is no reserving of camp sites, it is on a first come, first serve basis. Email carolhutton61@outlook.com. Bank Details: BSB: 124 001, A/C No.: 1040 9767.

4. **Access to Land and use of Vehicles and Trailers:** All access is via the access roads only. No vehicles and trailers are to be driven on Club Land (except for loading and unloading) and all Members are requested to park vehicles in an orderly fashion allowing room for others. Please respect rights of other campers.

5. **Showers and Toilets:** Members are requested to hose out these areas daily and to use the stainless steel troughs to wash sand off feet before entering. Many hands make light work.

6. **Barbecues:** The barbecues are to be cleaned after use incl drip trays and burners. Store gas bottle in kitchen.

7. **Kitchen:** The facilities are available for everyone to use. All refrigeration and freezer units are to be **cleaned**, left open when no longer in use and power turned off. All kitchen utensils, counters, fridges and floors must be cleaned upon departure from the Club Land. Hot water system to be put on vacation setting upon departing Club Land, leave gas bottle on. Please do not try to change the temp of the fridges, if you find they are getting too cold, they can be turned off at the wall for a while.

8. **Generator Shed and Solar:** As we now have a very workable Solar system, it is to be utilised whenever possible. There are detailed instructions for the Solar in the kitchen underneath the inverter. There have also been a lot more 12 volt lights installed, in the showers, outside areas, over the barby, etc. If there are not a lot of campers and there is sufficient refrigeration for everyone, the generator only needs to be run for a couple of hours a day to top up the water tank and also top up the batteries.

If any of the fridges aren't being used, can you please turn them off at the power point to conserve battery power. The instructions for turning on and off the generator are in the shed. The generator shed is not to be used for storage of anything. If possible, bring diesel across for the Genset and put into 200L drums. Send the invoice to the secretary and you will be reimbursed.

9. **Water:** Numerous taps are located around the Club land. Please use the sprinklers when possible. At no stage is the ball valve at the tank to be turned off.

10. **Buildings and Grounds:** Members are requested to spend a little time carrying out any maintenance needed, if it is within your capabilities. Any damaged or broken facilities to be reported promptly to a committee member or Club Secretary. All facilities to be cleaned, and locked up on departure and keys returned to the key safe provided. You are welcome to assist with gardening and site upkeep for the benefit of all and preservation of the area.

MBGFC - CLUB HOUSE AND LAND RULES

11. **Undercover Areas:** There is to be no camping under any roofed areas.
12. **Xmas Camping:** As Xmas is a very busy period, we have measured out camp sites. Most sites are across the front of the property and behind the gen shed. They measure a 5 m frontage and approx. 8 m depth.
13. **Firewood and Pets:** Moreton Island is a declared National Park and the cutting and gathering of wood is prohibited. Fires are prohibited anywhere on Moreton Island (could attract a fine in excess of \$600), except in MBGFC fire pit. Pets are prohibited on Moreton Island and hence Club Land.
Definitely no Fires are allowed on the Beach !
14. **Rubbish:** All rubbish is to be removed from Club Land to the Dump Master Bins near the wrecks or taken off the island. Fish are only to be cleaned on the outside stainless steel bench and thoroughly cleaned after use. All frames and gut are to be disposed of immediately.
15. **Vehicle Permits:** Qld National Parks Permits **Must** be obtained to take your vehicle to the Club Land on Moreton.
16. **Abuse of Rules:** Committee members have the authority to ask any tenants or visitors on the club property to leave should any abuse of the above rules occur.
